"It is very important, that organizers doesn't change the timetable! So, if timetable is unreasonable changed, FIRS RAD can demand a payment."

"It is very important, that organizers give the results of the races to FIRS RAD Homepage at the day of the race!" So, if results are loaded up later than two days after the race, FIRS RAD will demand a payment 100 Euro (all FIRS RAD Races)."

41.3 Starting ramp

The starting ramp should be build for a calm wait to the starting command. Breaks should not touch the ground.

In Slalom WC, WCH, Continental CH and WRG there has to be a starting ramp, minimum 1,5 m high! But in rainy conditions, Jury will decide.

There has to be some protection next to the ramp.

48.7 The apportioning of the prize money

For the particular standings the FIRS RAD World Cup, MEN/WOMEN (Overall)-Continental Championships and World Championships Races (not Team Race) Organizer makes min 660 € available for prizes. Other prizes are up to organizer.

22.4 Transmission of results

Each organizer will receive the login data for his race from FIRS-RAD TB (Analyses). The following data of WC and WR races must be uploaded to the website www.firs-rad.org:

After registration deadline:

- Starting List (only WR)

Not later than 2 days after the race:

- List of results of the organizer (only WR)
- Result data:

The data for the list header must be entered:

- Chief race, TD, Chief timing, Race distance
- 1st and 2nd run: course setters, number of gates, course condition, starting time If no result data has been transferred within 2 days after the race, FIRS RAD will demand a payment of 100 Euro!

46.1 Fees

Organizer fee is 1000 € for World Championship per race (in agreement with FIRS). Entry fee per racer per race is maximum 20 €. (The entry fee is paid to the organizer).

47.5 Fees

Organizer fee is 300 € for Continental Championship per race.

Entry fee per racer per race is maximum 15 €. (The entry fee is paid to the organizer).

48.1 Fees

Organizer fee is 500 € for World Cup per race (Organizer fee is to paied to FIRS RAD TC Bank Account until 1st May).

Entry fee per racer per race is maximum 15 €. (The entry fee is paid to the organizer).

48.5 starting list 2nd run

The limit 40m-40w best racers from the 1st run is applied for 2nd run. A starting-list for the second run must be announced in time and must be available in a sufficient quantity.

17. Continue after interruption of the race

17.1 The race is getting continued as soon as the maintain works are finished, when the weather conditions are changing so that a regular race can be granted.

17.2 The race continues with the first racer, that have not passed the track yet (not with the first racer in the category).

17.3 In case of the rain during the run, jury interrupts the race for racers to change their wheels and race continues where it has stopped. The results of racers, that have already passed the track are valid, no matter whether the surface conditions are changed.

17.4 The all-clear is made by the jury after the inspection of the track

16. Interruption of the race

16.1 By a functionary at the track

To carry out maintain works on the track, to grant a fair and regular race 16.2 By the jury

When rain starts to fall, the race is interrupted once. During the interruption the competitors can adjust their equipment to the new weather conditions.

16.3 In changing weather conditions, organizer should prepare equal conditions. Race track should be dried. It could be also flooded with water. Decision is made by the jury in cooperation with the organizer.

17.1 The race continues with the first racer in the category.

17.2 The all-clear is made by the jury after the inspection of the track.

16.1 By a functionary at the track

17. Restart of the race

17.1 The race is getting restarted as soon as the maintain works are finished / when the weather conditions are

changing so that a regular race can be granted.

17.2 The all-clear is made by the jury after the inspection of the track

36.17.1. Other conditions in PSL

When the racer is disqualified (further only DSQ) or does not finish (further only DNF) the first run, he losts. The opponent does not have to start in the second run and wins.

When the racer is DSQ or DNF the second run, he losts.

If both of the racers are DSQ or do DNF the first run, the winner is the racer, who passed the longer section of the track without mistake. They do not go the second run

If both of the racers did not pass the second run (DSQ or DNF), the result from the first run is decisive.

If both of the racers have same time in the first run and neither of them passes the second run (DSQ or DNF), the winner is the racer, who passed the longer section of the track without mistake.

If one of the racers does not get on the start and does not announce his resigning, the other racer must start to win. The other racer is winner immediately after starting, he does not have to pass the finish.

36.22.1 Other Positions in PSL

Racers are positioned on 5th-8th place according the time from the qualification. Racers are positioned on 9th-16th place according the time from the qualification.

Racers are positioned on 17th-32nd place the time from the qualification. In case of DNF or DSQ of the racer, the racer is clasified as a last one in particular run (8th, 16th, 32nd). In case that several racers are clasified DNF or DSQ in the same run are same, the time from the qualification is decisive.
