Welcome to all participants and especially F. Zangarini from World Skate.

World Skate is our new name. We do not change to "World Skate IAD" (Inline Alpine and Downhill), we remain at "World Skate RAD" (Roller Alpine and Downhill) → like in the statutes

3 possible persons for Regulations: Marek Stachowski (POL), Maria Martinez Moraiz (ESP) and Lenka Kesela (SVK).

Decision: new responsible person for Regulations is Maria Martinez Moraiz (ESP)

Marek Stachowski (POL) will be Development Coordinator, if he wants to.

Barbora Prochazkova will be the new Antidoping-Coordinator to support Sigi Zistler in questions of Antidoping.

2. WORLD SKATE support/inclusion of RAD TC

Greetings from our World Skate President.

Thanks to Sigi Zistler and Alexandre Lebrun for their work.

World Skate is now an Olympic Association, so every association under World Skate (also World Skate RAD) has to accept the rules from IOC (for example Anti-Doping Controls).

RAD TC has to step up and solve some actual problems.

World Skate will support RAD TC in every point.

The idea of World Skate is to have one big event for World Championships (World Roller Games) to unify rollersports. So they will have better arguments to find organizers for WRG in big cities. And also for other events like World Cups.

World Skate wants to hold seminars for TDs and coaches.

Most important is the development of the sport.

They want to fix goals and achieve results with a good structure.

Competitions in popular and big cities, example Rome, Paris, Barcelona \rightarrow good image for future events Competions shouldn't be organized like only one race. Competitions should be events \rightarrow camp for children, streetfood....

Communication: The Aim is to invent one website for all associations in World Skate (www.worldskate.org).

All informations from RAD-Homepage should be sent to Simona (Responsible person for Website in World Skate Association).

World Skate is also starting to design an application for smartphones.

World Championships in Saitama will be organized by a professional planning team.

Patricia Wallace is responsible for Antidoping in World Skate. She has to know the official calendar. She will contact the WADA. WADA will contact the national antidoping association to organize antidoping tests at our competitions. The national organizer has to pay the tests.

WRG Barcelona:

There will be a test race next February/March with new asphalt. During the race they want to invite all the national associations to inspect the conditions.

APP1: Jana Börsig/GER

38.8 Changing the race track

Nobody, except by instruction of the jury, is entitled to change poles, markings, flags or security facilities or break them down. When the track is changed less than 1 meter in all directions, the track doesn't have to be inspected again --> application: 20 cm max. 1 meter is way too much! If it is more than 20 cm then this gate has to be inspected again. For the sake of fairness and security.

But I recommend to make association's voting and then TC voting about this and if OK to use it for April Ismaning applications system.

Otherwise, it is not possible to discuss all applications from the time point of view and also there is no time to discuss more important questions.

CILA – Application 1

All associations of FIRS RAD can propose applications to the regulations. We suggest, however, that this limitation should apply to Ismaning conferences:

- the maximum number of applications to the association will be 3 if the association organizes at least 1 World Cup race each season
- the maximum number of applications to the association will be 2 if the association holds at least 1 World Cup race in two years
- the maximum number of applications to the association will be 2 if the association organizes at least 1 WR race in each season
- the maximum number of applications to the association will be 1 if the association organizes at least 1 WR race in two years



- the maximum number of applications to the RAD TC will be 1 at all
- The association which do not have any WR race organizing activities (see above) they can propose applications, but these will be only checked by RAD TC but will not be discussed or

RAD TC can use their limitation

- the proposed applications must be presented by the present representative of the proposing association

(the representation is not possible by other associations, skype is not possible)

→ No Vote. Sigi Zistler will look for it that there are not too many applications.

APP3: Lenka Kesela/SLO

Dear RAD TC,

In attachment, I am sending you the latest version of Reglement with applications from Sigi and from Spanish team. I had some problems with Spanish applications. I could not correct some of them, because I did not know, what is the correct form either. Here are those, I did not corrected:

Art. 8.5 - It says:

"If necessary he files an application for **MB** and Regulation Consultant to make decisions which cannot be made at the face"

What it is MB? Maybe TB (Task Board)?

MB = World skate RAD technical board

Art. 20.2 - It says:

- "- Official starting-time
- Official start time"

Is it the same? If not, which is the difference between them?

"- Official starting-time - cancel

Art. 36.18 - It says:

"Numbers

The competitors will race numbers and keep them until the end of the contest" It's out of context, because art. 36.18 is about the finish.



In Art 36.18 "Numbers

The competitors will race numbers and keep them until the end of the contest" - cancel

and put to:

Art.36.4.

The competitors will have the same race numbers until the end of the race.

Art. 36.18 - It says:

"Free ticket

Have a free ticket the competitors must attend at one of them freely chosen race course is a journey in order to advance a round"

It's out of context, because art. 36.18 is about the finish.

Art. 36.20 - It says:

• "Rankings. From the losing contestants each round, the rankings shown in each case by the smallest time difference"

It may be in contradiction with art. 36.22.

"Rankings. From the losing contestants each round, the rankings shown in each case by the smallest time difference" — cancel

My new application:

Art. 36.20

"A competitor for the next round of qualifying when his opponent is disqualified in one of two runs" - cancel

Everything is in Art 36.22

If you could send me your opinion on this issues, I will change it in the Reglement.

Application for the next WORLD SKATE MEETING in Ismaning in April 2018 Art. 49.3 of the Competition Rules

We would like to file an application for the meeting in Ismaning in April as follows:

Application:

Original text: "49.3 Non-active racers could be awarded "Continental Champion" too."

Art. 49.3 of the Competition Rules should be deleted.

Reasons:

Only athletes who have the status "Active" should be allowed to take part in international competitions as it is already common practice for World Cup and World Championships. There should be an uniform regulation concerning all international races.

APP5: WCH, CCH, every two years
Application for the next WORLD SKATE MEETING in Ismaning in April 2018
World Championships/Continental Championships

We would like to file an application for the meeting in Ismaning in April as follows:

Application:

World Championships should take place every 2 years during the World Roller Games. **Continental Championships** should take place every 2 years when there are **no** World Roller Games.



Reason:

The value of the title "World Champion" is not highly valuated if the World Championships take place every year.

There are enough great competitions as World Cup and World Ranking Races. Therefore, the World Championship should be a highlight every two years.

The athletes have immense costs for travelling abroad, e.g. China, Japan. It is unreasonable that the athletes carry these costs **every** year. Most athletes have to take over the costs by themselves because they are not supported by their associations or clubs.

→ No vote. That's not the decision of World Skate RAD TC. It's in the decision of Executive Board of World Skate. They allow WCH and CCH every year.

APP6: Japan --- Exception for one female racer from Japan

Title of application: Exception on age start authorization for WC and WCH in 2018

Name of applicant: Eiki Nagashima, IAJC Content of application: See below.

IAJC have a female racer who was born in early 2005. She is planning to attend the races as below in 2018.

- WC races in Degman or Spain
- WCH in Saitama

She has sufficient skill and technique to compete in the race course. In addition, she will participate these races at her own risk

Under the circumstances, we would like WSK technical committee to consider giving her a permission to participate these races as an exception.

10. Races 2019 (WRG 2019 Barcelona, World Cup, WR)

Ask Degmarn if they change their date because it's too close before WRG in Barcelona.

Organizers can contact World Skate (F. Zangarini) if there will be possibilities to organize events in bigger cities. World Skate stays in contact with bigger cities and work on it.

WRG Barcelona:

See attachement 5 (only in Spanish)

Proposal for WRG races in Barcelona:

- Max. 60 men and 60 women are allowed to start
- 60 men and 60 women in first and second run
- Same course in first and second run
- Third run with best 30 men and 30 women for TV (also same course)

Who is allowed to start:

15 best men and women of worldrankinglist

- 3 best men and women of a continent Kontinent (not under 15 best of worldrankinglist)
- 4 best men and women of nation (not under 15 best of worldrankinglist)
- 2 wildcards for organizer

Main idea: make it faster → more attractive for fans and TV

→ Wait for English version and then nations voting!

11. Different issues

Downhill: World Cup in Villablino and Tortoreto will be at the same time as World Cup of inline alpine.



They adjusted a bit to be at the same places with inline alpine. They want to built a bridge between both disciplines. Some skaters already switched between the disciplines.

They want more responsible persons in TC/TB (actually only 2).

Downhill has many problems to find organizers because it's very expensive to shut such tracks.

Francesco Zangarini offered to stay in contact to find good organizers and locations.

Villablino and Jirkov will look for suitable tracks for downhill to organize an event with inline alpine and downhill.
