- New Draft Worldskate Statutes (11 Disciplines -> splitting Inline Alpine and Downhill → new name: Inline Alpine Commission), ...) **APPENDIX 1** → Draft will be reviewed and approve by World Skate Congress July 3rd 2019 in Barcelona
- Worldskate Bylaws
- New Technical Rulebook Inline Alpine (for WRG 2019) → see APPENDIX 2
 - → Part 4.1. has to be changed: "According to <u>World Skate</u> doping-rules." instead of international doping-rules.
- New Technical requirement Inline Alpine (for WRG 2019) → see APPENDIX 3

1. Vote: No: 0 – Yes: 3 – Abstention: 0 (Distance between ramp and first pole)

Adds in competition rules 2019:

- 34.1. Technical Specifications
 - A slalom gate consists of a tilt-pole with a fixation-system
 - The distance from pole to pole may not be less than 3m and not more than 8m.
 - Not less than 30 gates and not more than 60 gates in 2 different colors



- Slalom must consist of horizontal (open) and vertical (blind) gates.
- Must feature one at minimum and three at maximum vertical combinations, consisting of three or four gates
- When possible 1-3 hairpin combinations
- The distance between the start and the first gate is measured from the end of the ramp.

35.1. Technical Specifications

- Gates A Giant Slalom consists of the two tilt-poles with a fixation system and a cloth spanned between. The cloth should get released from the pole in the case of too heavy contact.
- Space between the gates The distance from one tilt-pole to the other tilt pole may not be less than 10m and not more than 15m.
- Number of gates Not less than 20 gates and not more than 35 gates in 2 different colours
- Combination of gates A Giant Slalom contains a rotation of big, middle a small radiuses. The competitor must have a freedom of choosing his trail between the gates.
- The distance between the start and the first gate is measured from the end of the ramp. Distance remains the same, 10-15m.

2. Vote: No: 0 − Yes: 2 − Abstention: 1 (27.4 Bad sportsmanship → add yellow card)

27.4. Bad sportsmanship

Bad sportsmanship includes:

- intentional track equipment damage by athlete
- verbal abuse and swear word use against other persons
- other bad sportsmanship related action

By violating these norms, athlete is fined 50 EUR unconditionally from WORLD SKATE RAD TC.

New part:

"By violating these norms, the jury has the possibility of first warning through a yellow card or giving the runner a 100 EUR fine. The action should be declared together with disqualifications after the race and also written in official results. Racer will have this warning during the whole season on all World Ranking races and races where the arranger is World Skate Inline Alpine and Downhill Technical Commission. If a bad behavior action is repeated, jury must punish him with 100 EUR fine."

Bernd Altmann will add a yellow and red card (in the crack "Status") on the competitor list. If someone received a yellow card in the past, the TD is able to check it there. There will be also a yellow dot in front of his/her name on the start lists of the next races of this year. Yellow card will resist for the whole season. After the season they will be cleared.

3. Vote: No: 0 – Yes: 3 – Abstention: 0 (36.16 Disqualifications PSL: no test run in PSL)

36.16. Disqualifications

- If the competitor does not affect the at least one skate board.
- On the command "Go" to start (false start).
- The competitor does not have both sticks in the designated and marked areas.
- Changing from one course to another 2 Intentionally or unintentionally obstruct the opponent
- crossing the dividing line at the finish line
- Gate faults
- Racer is disqualified when he breaks through the start doors before they are opened.



- More opportunities for disqualification :
- When the racer is disqualified (further only DSQ) or does not finish (further only DNF) the first run, he loses. The opponent does not have to start in the second run and wins.
- When the racer is DSQ or DNF the second run, he loses.
- If both of the racers are DSQ or do DNF the first run, the winner is the racer, who passed the longer section of the track without mistake. They do not go the second run.
- If both of the racers did not pass the second run (DSQ or DNF), the result from the first run is decisive.
- If both of the racers have same time in the first run and neither of them passes the second run (DSQ or DNF), the winner is the racer, who passed the longer section of the track without mistake.
- If one of the racers does not get on the start and does not announce his resigning, the other racer must start to win. The other racer is winner immediately after starting, he does not have to pass the finish.
- If one of the racers does not get on the start and does not announce his resigning, he loses the race. The other racer cannot start. Test run is forbidden.

APP 4 barrier material S. Zistler/GER

39.3. Material needed

The head of material and technical constructional systems has to prepare following things:

- Slalom poles in two different colors
- Enough platforms
- A corresponding amount of flags, compatibly to the slalom pole
- Chalk or tabs for marking the poles
- Chalk or colors for marking the position of the poles
- Barrier material: metal bends are forbidden. Only plastic bends and nets are allowed.
- Rebound mats
