1. Greetings

2. New Rulebook 2021

It is necessary to apply the rulebook and the bylaws to the structure of WORLD SKATE. The rulebook should be updated and sent to WORLD SKATE sportsdepartment by May $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$. After WORLD SKATE sportsdepartment has viewed the rulebook it can be published.

There are no relevant changes in the rulebook. Only the age for participants who may start at Word Cups has been adjusted accordingly (2006 and older).

3. Season 2021 and 2022

Because of the upredictable development of the corona pandemic some organizers had to cancel their World Cup races. Up to now 6 World Cup races are planned in 2021, Vuzenica/SLO, Vysoka Pec/CZE, Spiska Nova/SVK, Vranje/SRB, Villablino/ESP and the World Cup final in Oviedo/ESP.

1st race will take place in Vuzenica/SLO on 29th (WR-Race) and 30th (WC-Race) of May.

The organizer had to change the racetrack because the average gradient of the originally track (in the city of Vuzenica) was not according to the rulebook (6%-15%).

The new racetrack is a little bit outside of the city of Vuzenica but fulfills all criteria. A video was kindly published on social media by the organizer.

Homologation of the new track will be on Friday before the racing weekend. Due to the corona pandemic, this procedure is an exception.

There have been a few protests regarding this approach. The new racetrack ist not the most suitable for the World Cup because of the location and the conditions of the asphalt.

The organizer will show some more videos and pictures of the new track to the technical commission. They will decide on which track the World Cup will take place. -> Decision was made on 3rd of May 2021: New Race track is confirmed!

4. Bidding for World Cup 2022, Situation WRG Argentina 2022

WORLD SKATE sportsdepartment and Sigi are working on bidding template for season 2022. Soon it will be published.

Next season bidding prodedure will change. Biddings have to be submitted directly to WORLD SKATE sportsdepartment through the national roller sport association. Technical commission checks the track and organize the homologation.

World Roller Games will take place in San Juan/Argentina between Oktober and November 2022. The exact period has not yet been defined. There will be more details until the next meeting.

5. Academy for Jugdes/Coaches

There will be new courses for Jugdes and Coaches in the end of this year or in the beginning of the nex year.

The courses are organized by WORLD SKATE sportsdepartment. The courses will be subject to a fee, how much
